## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to reduce the short-term capital gains tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any laws to the contrary, taxable income consisting of
- 2 short-term capital gains, as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, shall be
- 3 taxed at the rate of 5 percent.
