An Act relative to embarkation fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 65 of the Acts of 2004 hereby amended by the following:-

2 Section 1. Section 11 of Chapter 55 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by sections 44-47 of  
3 Chapter 65 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby further amended by adding the following section:

4 Section 11A. The Hyannis Fire District of the Town of Barnstable is hereby authorized to collect  
5 a voter approved embarkation fee from the ferry services that operate in the Hyannis Fire  
6 District. Said fee will be \$.25 per passenger per ticket sold for all passenger ferry trips in the  
7 Hyannis Fire District. Such Fire District is authorized to establish a separate fund to be known as  
8 the Embarkation Fee Fund, which shall be kept separate and apart from other revenues of the  
9 Hyannis Fire District by the Treasurer of the Hyannis Fire District. Fees collected from  
10 passengers departing and returning to the Hyannis Fire District ports shall be remitted to the

- 11 Massachusetts Commissioner of Revenue. The Commissioner shall deposit collected fees to the
- 12 Embarkation Fee Fund of the Hyannis Fire District. Funds from the Embarkation Fee Fund shall
- 13 be used for fire and public safety services provided by the Hyannis Fire District.
