An Act excluding the Segal AmeriCorps Educational Award from taxable income.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in paragraph (a) of Subsection B by adding the following  
3 subparagraph (20): The AmeriCorps Segal Education Award, as stipulated in subtitle D of title I  
4 of the National and Community Service Act of 1990. The AmeriCorps Segal Education Award is  
5 available to individuals who complete a term of service in the AmeriCorps program. The  
6 education award can be used to pay education costs at eligible institutions of higher learning  
7 including technical schools, for educational training, or to repay qualified student loans, as  
8 determined eligible by the federal government.

9           SECTION 2. This law shall become effective 180 days after its passage.
