An Act to mitigate snowbird relocation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2A of Chapter 65C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph at the end of  
3 subsection (a):-

4 For decedents dying after December thirty-first, two thousand twenty-two, no tax shall be  
5 imposed pursuant to this subsection that reduces the decedent’s Massachusetts net estate to an  
6 amount less than two million dollars.
