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An Act relative to property tax deferrals for seniors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Clause forty-first A of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2            2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 1170-1171, the words “the rate  
3            provided in section sixty-two of chapter sixty”, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4            words:- a rate equal to the prime rate, as reported by the federal reserve board in federal reserve  
5            statistical release H. 15, plus 2%.
