An Act establishing a tax credit for veteran license plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 6 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after subsection (w) the following subsection:-
- 3 (x) There is hereby established a credit for residents who possess a veteran license plate
- 4 issued pursuant to paragraphs 7 through 18, 26, 28, and 29 of section 2 of chapter 90 of the
- 5 General Laws, as so appearing.
- The amount of such credit shall be equal to any amount paid, in a given tax year, for a
- 7 registration fee, special plate fee, or renewal fee of any veteran license plate issued pursuant to
- 8 paragraphs 7 through 18, 26, 28, and 29 of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so
- 9 appearing.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 shall be effective for tax years beginning on or after January 1,
- 11 2023.
