An Act relative to municipal tax collectors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the final paragraph and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following:-

4 “The collector may, in his discretion, waive such interest, charges and fees, up to 50% of  
5 the total tax liability for any given tax period.”
