**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to bidding for public construction contracts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection 2 of section 44D of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, in
3 lines 66-67, inclusive, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

4 An application for a certificate of eligibility and update statements shall be a public
5 record as defined in section 7 of chapter 4 except that financial information contained in the
6 application shall not be a public record.

7 SECTION 2. Subsection 12 of said section 44D, of said chapter 149, as so appearing, is
8 hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, in lines 279-281, inclusive, and inserting in
9 place thereof the following sentence:

10 Applications for a certificate of eligibility and update statements shall be a public record
11 as defined in section 7 of chapter 4 except that financial information contained in the application
12 shall not be a public record.
