**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to discrimination against cash buyers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10A of chapter 255D of the General Laws is hereby amended by at
2 the end thereof, the following words: "No retail or service establishment of any kind shall require
3 the transfer of cash into electronic debit or credit cards to process transactions. All
4 establishments shall be required to accept cash for any transaction."
