An Act relative to Rosa Parks Day.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith February 4th as Rosa Parks Day, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after Section 15BBBBBB, the following section:-

3 The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside February fourth as Rosa
4 Parks Day, in lasting recognition of a historic civil rights leader and recommend that the day be
5 observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
