Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 6A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 7A the following section:-
- 3 SECTION 7B. The Executive Office of Technology Services and Security shall establish
- 4 the Office of Science Services. This agency shall consist of seven members of the scientific
- 5 community to be appointed by the Chief Information Officer. Members of the Office of Science
- 6 Services may provide scientific guidance to members of the General Court and executive
- 7 agencies. Each member of the Office of Science Services shall be appointed for terms of five
- 8 years.
