Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 30B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the first paragraph, the following paragraph: -
- Notwithstanding the provisions of any other section of this Chapter, public procurement
- 4 units that conduct a cooperative purchasing agreement may award contracts to multiple offerors
- 5 through a request for proposals if their chief procurement officer determines that doing so is in
- 6 the best interests of the parties to the cooperative purchasing agreement.
