In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to remove woody biomass from the greenhouse gas emissions standard for municipal lighting plants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 11F3/4 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as appearing in the

- 2 2020 Official Edition, and as amended by Section 34 of Chapter 8 of the Acts of 2021, is hereby
- 3 further amended in clause (i) of subsection (c) by striking the words "biomass fuel; and (11)".
- 4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
