An Act relative to the used vehicle record book.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 62 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           In lieu of keeping and maintaining a book or other such form as approved by the  
4 registrar, as required in this section, a class 1 dealer, licensed pursuant to sections 58 and 59,  
5 shall be deemed to be in compliance with this section by recording and maintaining the  
6 information required herein in said dealer’s electronic data management system, in a form and in  
7 a format approved by the registrar; provided, however, that such form and format approved by  
8 the registrar shall not compel the dealer to engage in duplicate recording and maintenance of the  
9 information for each vehicle.
