### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to improved headlight safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 90 is hereby amended by inserting:
- All new automobiles sold in the Commonwealth after January 1, 2026, shall be equipped
- 3 with adaptive beam headlight technology, as authorized by the amendment to the Federal Motor
- 4 Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108 by the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway
- 5 Traffic Safety Administration.
