An Act relative to speed limits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 17C of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the word “inside” and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following words:-

4           ", including, but not limited to, a roadway on which a speed limit higher than 25 miles  
5 per hour was previously established pursuant to section 18, inside".
