An Act relative to roadway safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 11 of Chapter 89 as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is 2 hereby amended, in line 3 by striking out the word "pedestrian" and inserting in place thereof, 3 the words "vulnerable user as defined by in Section 1 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws" 4 SECTION 2: Said Section 11 of Chapter 89, is hereby amended, in lines 5, 7, 11, 12, and 5 18 by striking out the word "pedestrian" and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the 6 words "vulnerable user" 7 SECTION 3: Said Section 11 of Chapter 89, is hereby amended, in line 4 by striking out 8 the words "crosswalk marked" and inserting in place thereof, the words "marked crossing"
- 9 SECTION 4: Said Section 11 of Chapter 89, is hereby amended, in line 13 by striking out 10 the words "crosswalk" and inserting in place thereof, the words "marked crossing"
- SECTION 5: Said Section 11 of Chapter 89, is hereby amended, in line 11, 12, and 18 by striking out the words "crosswalk" and inserting in place thereof, the words "crossing"
