**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act increasing the penalties for passing a stopped school bus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 14 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the figure “\$250”, in line 30, the following words:- and a 7
- 3 day suspension of the person’s license or right to operate a motor vehicle.
