## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to tax notification for veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 60 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 35 the following section:-
- 3 Section 35A. (a) No municipality shall publish or cause to be published the name, or
- 4 other individually identifying information, of a veteran still owing a tax pursuant to this chapter
- 5 after it has become due and payable.
- 6 (b) A municipality may communicate through the municipality's veterans' agent in order
- 7 to provide notice and information related to a tax due and payable under this chapter to the
- 8 veteran owing such tax.

- 9 SECTION 2. Section 21 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "taxpayers", in line 70, the
- following words:-; provided, however, that the name and address of a veteran shall not be
- 12 published as part of said list.
