An Act relative to treating veterans under the pension laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding section 9A of chapter 30 of the General Laws, or any other general or  
2 special law to the contrary, the rights afforded to a veteran, under said section 9A of said chapter  
3 30, shall also be afforded to any such veteran who holds a position of justice of the supreme  
4 judicial court, justice of the appeals court or justice of the trial court as so provided in Chapter III  
5 of Part the Second of the Constitution who has held that office or position for not less than 10  
6 years.
