Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Chapter 15A of the Massachusetts General Laws, as so appearing in the
- 2 2020 official edition, are hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 3 "Section 46: The council shall develop and adopt a written policy requiring each public
- 4 institution of higher education to offer and administer online courses free of charge to any
- 5 Veteran of Massachusetts as defined by M.G.L. ch. 4, s.7, clause 43."
