In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act concerning the use of a prescription medicine that contains 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA).

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (j) Any person or entity registered to prescribe, manufacture, distribute, dispense or
- 4 provide services related to 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA) shall not charge
- 5 more than \$5,000 per MDMA treatment service unit. For the purposes of this subsection,
- 6 "MDMA treatment service unit" shall mean any prescribed and controlled administration of
- 7 MDMA in any 7-day consecutive period including therapy and related counseling.
- 8 SECTION 2. Paragraph (a) of Class B of section 31 of chapter 94C of the General Laws,
- 9 as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out clause (8).
- SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act shall take effect upon the approval of 3,4—
- methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA) as a prescription drug by the United States Food

- 12 and Drug Administration and the secretary of the commonwealth shall publish notice of the
- 13 effective date of this act in the Massachusetts Register.
