An Act relative to requiring insurance providers cover a minimum of 30 days for in-patient substance abuse treatment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 17N of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 23, the figure “14” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following figure:- 30.

4 SECTION 2. Section 10H of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
5 hereby amended by striking out, in line 46, the figure “14” and inserting in place thereof the  
6 following figure:- 30.

7 SECTION 3. Section 47GG of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
8 hereby amended by striking out, in line 24, the figure “14” and inserting in place thereof the  
9 following figure:- 30.

10 SECTION 4. Section 8II of chapter 176A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
11 amended by striking out, in line 23, the figure “14” and inserting in place thereof the following
