An Act relative to apportionment of lottery revenues.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 18C of chapter 58, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out subsection (a) and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 subsection:-
- 4 (a) In this section, "budgeted aid" shall mean unrestricted aid to cities and towns
- 5 payments in lieu of taxes from the commonwealth to cities and towns and education aid to cities
- 6 and towns under chapter 70.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 18C of chapter 58, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 8 after subsection (a) the following subsection:-

- 9 (b) State lottery revenue shall be apportioned to cities and towns proportionate to lottery
- sales in those cities and towns.
