Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 165 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 11E the following section:-
- 3 Section 11F. Any city, town, district or company engaged in supplying water to
- 4 customers shall include a list of all billing discounts available to seniors, veterans or persons with
- 5 disabilities on every water bill to a customer.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 1D of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 7 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 8 All electric and gas bills sent to a retail customer shall include a list of all billing
- 9 discounts available to seniors, veterans or persons with disabilities.
- SECTION 3. Chapter 25C of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 11 following section:-

Section 10. All bills for services provided to consumers by companies subject to the supervision of the department pursuant to section 1 shall include a list of all billing discounts available to seniors, veterans or persons with disabilities.
