In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act directing the city of Boston police department to waive the maximum age requirement for police officers for Wendy Pierre-Louis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1.

2 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the provisions of

3 Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive the maximum

- 4 age requirement for original appointment of police officers for Wendy Pierre-Louis. If Wendy
- 5 Pierre-Louis meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police Department, he shall be
- 6 eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer.

7 Section 2.

8 The provisions of this act shall take effect immediately upon passage.
