## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to school bus safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 Every school bus that is used for the transportation of school children to and from a
- 4 public, charter, vocational, private or parochial school or in connection with school activities
- 5 shall be equipped with seatbelts for each permanent seating accommodation on the school bus in
- 6 compliance with applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards. Any person or company
- 7 contracting with or intending to contract with a school district or a charter, vocational, private or
- 8 parochial school for the transportation of school children, shall file a notice with the department
- 9 of elementary and secondary education affirming that all school buses, to be utilized in
- 10 performance of the contract, are in compliance with this paragraph.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect 1 year after its passage; provided, however, that
- any person or company that is a party to a contract existing as of the effective date of section 1

- with a school district or a charter, vocational, private or parochial school for the transportation of
- school children, shall notify the department of elementary and secondary education that its
- school buses are in compliance with section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended
- by section 1, as soon as compliance occurs and no later than the effective date of section 1.
