**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act to limit fees charged in a rental real estate transaction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 87DDD½ of chapter 112, of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following sentence:- No licensed broker or salesperson shall charge a tenant a fee for services
- 3 relating to finding a dwelling accommodation or for any other service unless the tenant has
- 4 sought out and hired that broker or salesperson to provide the tenant with such services.
