An Act relative to the Assistant Clerks of the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 94 of chapter 221 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
2 striking the sentence: “The salary of the assistant clerks of the supreme judicial court for Suffolk  
3 county shall be 82.50 per cent of the salary of said clerk and shall be paid, subject to  
4 appropriation, by the commonwealth.”, and insert in place thereof the following: -

5           The salary of the second assistant clerk of the supreme judicial court for Suffolk county  
6 shall be 85.88 per cent of the salary of said clerk and the salary of the third assistant clerk of the  
7 supreme judicial court for Suffolk county shall be 82.50 per cent of the salary of said clerk and  
8 shall be paid, subject to appropriation, by the commonwealth.
