An Act relative to changing the term of the elected office of moderator for the town of Stoneham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 26 of the acts of 1981, as amended by section 4 of  
2 chapter 296 of the acts of 1994, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 21, the term “2  
3 yrs.” and inserting in place thereof the term “3 yrs.”

4           SECTION 2. The act shall take effect upon its passage.
