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1 *Ordered,* That the committee on Public Health be authorized to sit during a recess of the
2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 2181 and
3 2277, relative to unborn victims of Down Syndrome and the health of mothers and born alive
4 fetuses after the second trimester.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
8 on or before December 31, 2024.
