## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act authorizing the town of Westford to issue an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
- 2 licensing authority of the town of Westford may grant one additional license for the sale of all
- alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138 to 3
- 4 Nab's One Stop Shop, Inc., located at 60 Brookside Road in the town. A license granted under
- 5 this section shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

(b) The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of a license issued under this

- 9 letter from the department of unemployment assistance indicating that the license is in good
- standing with those departments and that all applicable taxes, fees, and contributions have been 10

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- 12 (c) If a licensee terminates or fails to renew a license granted under this section or any
- 13 such license is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall be returned physically, with all of

- the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority, which
  may, within 3 years after such return, then grant the license to a new applicant at the same
  location under the same conditions as specified in this section, otherwise such license shall
  dissolve.
  - (d) The license granted under this act shall be issued within 1 year after the effective date of this act; provided, however, that if the license is originally granted within that time period, that it may be granted to a new applicant under subsections (b) and (c) thereafter.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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
