An Act directing the City of Boston Police Department to waive the maximum age requirement for police officers for Terrance Joseph Williams.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section I.

2           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the provisions of  
3 Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive the maximum  
4 age requirement for original appointment of police officers for Terrance Joseph Williams. If  
5 Terrance Joseph Williams meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police  
6 Department, he shall be eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the  
7 position of police officer.

8           Section 2.

9           The provisions of this act shall take effect immediately upon passage.
