## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to expand the Massachusetts School Building Authority and create a new program to assist public school districts with 21st century technology upgrades.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

| 1 | Chapter 70B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-               |

| 2 | Section 21. The authority shall create a technology upgrade program for school districts          |
| 3 | to provide partial funding throughout the commonwealth for school technology upgrades. The        |
| 4 | technology upgrade program shall be a competitive grant program and its grants shall be           |
| 5 | distributed by the authority on the basis of need and urgency. The authority shall maintain       |
| 6 | funding for all capital programs in existence on January 1, 2023 in an amount equal to or greater |
| 7 | than the funding for said programs in fiscal year 2023.   |
