## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act providing for payment by the Commonwealth of wages for members of the United States Coast Guard during the shut-down, so-called, of the United States Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the salaries of members of the
- 2 United States Coast Guard who are residents of the commonwealth shall be paid by the
- 3 commonwealth, subject to appropriation, during the pendency of any so-called federal
- 4 government shut-down. The funds for such payments shall be paid from an account to be
- 5 determined by the Governor. Upon the conclusion of the so-called federal government shut-
- 6 down, the Commonwealth shall seek reimbursement from the federal government for the costs of
- 7 any such payments made.
