By Representative Giannino of Revere, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4551) of Jessica Ann Giannino and Jeffrey Rosario Turco (with the approval of the mayor and city council) relative to the filling of vacancies in the office of mayor of the city of Revere. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to the filling of vacancies in the office of mayor of the city of Revere.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2011 is hereby repealed.

2 Section 2. Section 1 of Chapter 147 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby repealed and inserting

3 in place thereof the following new Section 1.:

4 Notwithstanding section 59A of chapter 43 of the General Laws, if a vacancy a) 5 occurs in the office of mayor of the city of Revere by death, removal, resignation, or otherwise, 6 at any time during the first year, the first 6 months of the second year, the third year and the first 7 6 months of the fourth year of the mayor's term of office, the city clerk shall immediately order 8 an election to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term. A vacancy shall not be 9 filled in the manner provided in this section if the vacancy occurs during the last 6 months of the 10 term of office of mayor. If a vacancy occurs in the office of mayor within 6 months of the city's 11 regular municipal election, in the second year of the mayor's term of office, the city clerk shall

order an election to fill such vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term at the city's regularmunicipal election.

b) The president of the city council shall perform the duties of mayor until a new
mayor is elected and sworn to the faithful discharge of his duties. The president of the city
council shall be called "acting mayor" and he shall possess the powers of mayor only in matters
not admitting of delay.

18 c) The mayor-elect chosen at such election shall take office immediately upon the 19 certification of the results of the election and shall be sworn to the faithful discharge of the 20 mayor's duties. Unless a councillor serving as acting mayor under this section formally resigns, 21 the councillor shall, upon the election and qualification of a successor mayor, resume their 22 service as a councillor in the capacity to which they were elected and shall serve for the 23 remainder of the unexpired term.

d) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall not be a
preliminary election to fill the vacancy in the office of mayor. Candidates seeking to fill the
vacancy, whose nomination papers have been duly certified, shall be considered to have been
nominated.

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
