An Act authorizing employment contracts with persons serving as Deputy Police Chief in the town of Milford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 108A and 108C of chapter 41 of the General  
2   Laws, and any by-law adopted thereunder, the Town of Milford, acting by and through its Select  
3   Board, may establish employment contracts with persons serving as Deputy Police Chief upon  
4   the same terms and conditions, and subject to the same limitations as contained within section  
5   108O of said Chapter 41, applicable to other municipal employees as designated in that section.

6           SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
