**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the minimum years of service required to be eligible for a civil service promotion to the position of fire lieutenant in the town of Milford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law, charter, by-law, rule or regulation to the contrary in order to be eligible for a civil
3 service promotion to the rank of fire lieutenant within the fire department in the Town of
4 Milford, an applicant must have at least 5 years of service in the rank of firefighter or higher
5 within a civil service fire department. A person who does not meet this requirement shall not be
6 eligible to take a promotional examination for the position of fire lieutenant in the Milford fire
7 department. Except as otherwise provided herein, applicants for promotional appointments shall
8 be subject to all applicable provisions of said chapter 31.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
