**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act to regulate school enrollment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (n) of Section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof

4 the following two sentences:-

5 Enrollment in a commonwealth charter school shall use an opt-out admissions lottery
6 process that automatically includes the names of all eligible students, without any required
7 application process for the school. A commonwealth charter school’s tuition payment shall be
8 adjusted to account for any students who cannot attend said school because necessary services
9 are not available.
