An Act to regulate school enrollment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Subsection (n) of Section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in
- 3 place thereof
- 4 the following two sentences:-
- 5 Enrollment in a commonwealth charter school shall use an opt-out admissions lottery
- 6 process that automatically includes the names of all eligible students, without any required
- 7 application process for the school. A commonwealth charter school's tuition payment shall be
- 8 adjusted to account for any students who cannot attend said school because necessary services
- 9 are not available.
