The committee on Children, Families and Persons with Disabilities, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 128) of Christine P. Barber and others relative to ensuring equal access to medical treatments essential for people with a developmental disability, intellectual disability, or autism; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 158) of Tricia Farley-Bouvier and others relative to establishing the Massachusetts foster care review office; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 191) of Kay Khan and others relative to a livable wage for human services workers, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4872) ought to be adopted.

1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Children, Families and Persons with Disabilities be  
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of  
3 House documents numbered 128, 158 and 191, relative to medical treatment, foster care and  
4 wages.

6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
8 on or before December 31, 2024.
