The committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2378) of Paul McMurtry and Patrick Joseph Kearney relative to the Massachusetts peace officer standards and training commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2394) of David M. Rogers, Marjorie C. Decker and others relative to the right of persons incarcerated in correctional institutions, state prisons, jails or houses of correction to confer with news media representative; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2408) of Jeffrey Rosario Turco relative to the membership of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2409) of Jeffrey Rosario Turco that law enforcement departments provide resources to ensure officers can make accurate statements; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3863) of Susan Williams Gifford and Joseph D. *House of Representatives, August 15, 2024.*

*Ordered,* That the committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security be authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 2378, 2394, 2408, 2409 and 3863, relative to Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission, incarcerated persons and other public safety and homeland security issues

Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2024.
