In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to interest fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking lines 50 and 51, and inserting in place thereof the
3	following:-

- 4 "The collector may, in his discretion, waive such interest, charges and fees, up to 50% of
- 5 the total tax liability for any given tax period."
