### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to amend the Saugus Town Charter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 17 of the Acts of 1947 also known as the Saugus Town Charter is hereby
- 2 amended, by adding under Article 2, Section 6 a new paragraph which shall be identified as
- 3 "Section 6a Prohibitions" which will read as follows:
- 4 "No former member of the Board of Selectmen or School Committee shall hold any
- 5 compensated appointed office, position, or employment that is directly appointed by the Board of
- 6 Selectmen or School Committee for which a salary or other emolument is payable from the town
- 7 treasury until eighteen months following the date on which the former member's term of office,
- 8 as established by this Act, on the Board of Selectmen or School Committee has terminated."
