An Act to strengthen suicide prevention in schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 95 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 29, the words "3 years" and inserting
3 in place thereof the word "year".

4 SECTION 2. Section 95 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 30, the words "6 months" and
6 inserting in place thereof the words "60 days".

7 SECTION 3. Section 95 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
8 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

9 The department, subject to appropriation, shall adopt rules to require that all public
10 school districts and commonwealth charter schools adopt a policy to identify and develop

- 11 partnerships with community organizations and agencies for referring students to health, mental
- 12 health, substance use and social support services.
