Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph:- There shall
- 3 be training relative to de-escalation tactics and techniques approved by the commissioner of
- 4 education required for all school bus operators. If employed, the operator's employer shall pay
- 5 for the cost of the de-escalation training.
