Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 25B of said chapter 54, as appearing in section 10 of chapter 92 of
- 2 the acts of 2022, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
- 3 (1) The state secretary shall prepare uniform applications, instructions, ballot styles,
- 4 envelopes, and other papers and electronic documents without distinguishing early voting by
- 5 mail from absent voting under this chapter.
