**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to health care proxies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 2 of Chapter 201D, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
2 Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of section 2:- The proxy shall remain
3 in effect and not be revoked due to death of the principal until 6 months from the time of the
4 principal has deceased.
