**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to acceptance of AP scores for college credit.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding after section 45 the following section:-

- 3 Section 46. The department of higher education is hereby directed to promulgate
- 4 regulations establishing a standard whereby college credit is guaranteed at state colleges and
- 5 universities for students who achieve an Advanced Placement exam score of 3 or higher.
