**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act to amend special legislation to pursue five (5) additional alcohol pouring licenses in Hudson's C-1 Zoning District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 57 of the Acts of 2019 is hereby amended by striking
2 out subsection (e), and inserting in place thereof the following new subsection:-

3 (e) All licenses granted pursuant to this act shall be issued not later than six years after
4 the effective date of this act; provided, however, that a license originally granted within that time
5 period may be granted to a new applicant pursuant to subsection (c) or (d) any time thereafter.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
